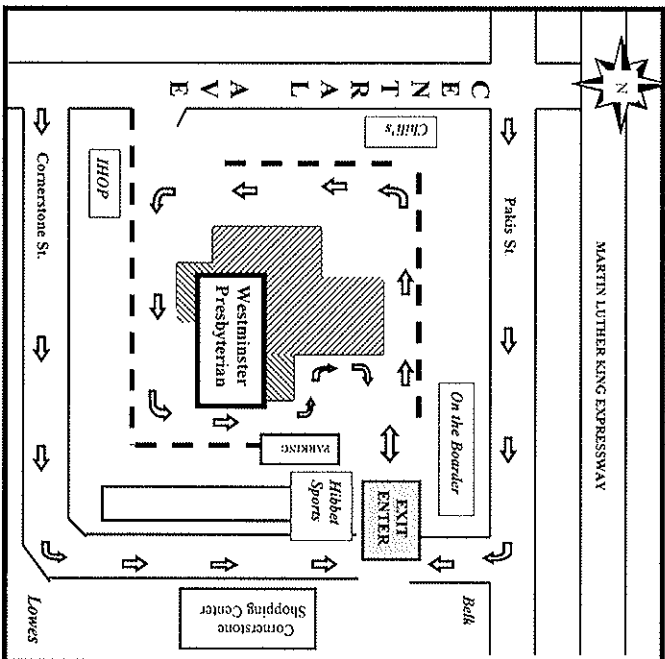


What I need to know to place an order:

- ◆ *Anyone may place an order. There is no application to complete.*
 - ◆ *Place your order on the dates, times, and at the locations listed on the Monthly Menu/Order Form. Orders may be placed on-line at www.angelfoodministries.com*
 - ◆ *A Signature Box of food is \$30.00. Additional boxes and specials are offered each month and vary in price. Any quantity may be ordered.*
 - ◆ *Payment is made at the time the order is placed. Payment must be cash, money order (made payable to Angel Food), or by EBT (food stamps). Exact change requested.*
 - ◆ *Pick up your order at the Church during the designated times and dates listed on the Monthly Menu.*
 - ◆ *Refer to the Angel Food Calendar for distribution dates and times.*
- Orders that are not picked up on the designated date and time will be donated.

Blessings by the Box

Once a month, you (or someone you want to help) can be blessed with wonderful boxes of frozen meats, fresh or frozen fruits and vegetables, and staple items at an extremely low price.

Angel Food's groceries are sold for \$30.00 per Signature Box. Each month's set menu is different than the previous month with an average retail value between \$42.00 and \$78.00.

In addition to the Signature box, additional standard boxes and monthly specials are also available and vary monthly by item and price. There is no limit to the number of boxes an individual may purchase.

Generally, one Signature Box of food assists in feeding a family of four for about one week or a single senior citizen for almost a month. There are no second-hand, damaged, or out-dated goods. The food is purchased from major food producers throughout the country to ensure the best food comes to your table.

Donations are graciously accepted and will go directly to the purchase of food for distribution to families in need.

Angel Food returns a small amount, per unit sold, to the host site for use in out-reach ministries.

About Angel Food

In response to a call to serve, the Angel Food Ministries program was established in the community of Hot Springs, in November of 2004. In December of 2006, Westminster Presbyterian Church became the distribution hub for the area.

Angel Food is a non-profit, non-denominational organization dedicated to providing grocery relief and financial support to communities throughout the United States. The program began with 34 families in Monroe, Georgia in 1994, and has grown to serve hundreds of thousands of families every month across 35 states. Angel Food Ministries crosses denominational lines and has spread the good news of the gospel of Christ through "salvation tracts" that are placed in each food order.

Please note that our order dates may vary from those listed on the Angel Food website.

How it Works

There are no applications to complete or qualifications to which participants must adhere. Angel Food Ministries also participates in the U.S. Food Stamp program, (EBT card) using the Off-Line Food Stamp Voucher system.

Food orders and payments must be received by the dates listed on the Angel Food Calendar along with an accepted form of payment. If using an EBT Card (food stamps) the funds must be available on the date the order is placed.

A MONTHLY MENU along with the ORDER FORM is made available on the previous month's distribution date. Orders may be placed at that time or on a later date as noted on the MENU/ ORDER FORM. On-line ordering is also available at: www.angelfoodministries.com

A receipt will be issued for each order. The orders are compiled, along with total payment, and forwarded to the Angel Food office in Monroe, Georgia. The food is shipped and distributed across the country on the Saturday specified on the Angel Food Calendar.

Volunteers from the Church and community come together to sort the food for distribution. On the same day, customers are then asked to pick up their food at Westminster. Drive-through service is provided.
